GOVERNOR ANNOUNCES APPOINTMENTS TO TWO BOARDS

Governor Ann Richards has announced the appointment of Peter Clifton Lewis of Dallas to a new position on the Texas Public Finance Authority Board of Directors. He will serve a term extending to Feb. 1, 1993.

Lewis, 35, is an attorney with the law firm of Jenkens & Gilchrist. A graduate of Princeton University, he earned a law degree from the Columbia University School of Law.

Lewis is a member of the American, National and Dallas Bar Associations, the Texas Bar Foundation and the State Bar of Texas.

He is a trustee of the Dallas Alliance, a director of the Dallas County Mental Health Association and is a member of the citizens advisory board of the Day Resource Center.

In addition, Lewis is a director of both the Texas Lyceum Association, Inc. and Goodwill Industries.

This appointment is subject to Senate confirmation.

The Governor also named James H. Flinchum of Rockwall to the State Depository Board. He will serve until Aug. 22, 1993.

Flinchum is replacing Robert L. Monaghan of Midland, whose term expired.

This appointment is subject to Senate confirmation.

Flinchum, 44, is president of Convesta, Inc., a consulting firm specializing in international finance, restructuring and mergers. He earned a bachelor's degree in finance from Old Dominion University, a master's in international finance from the University of Dallas and his MBA in finance from the College of William and Mary.

Flinchum, who served as vice president of Citicorp for five years, is a member of the College of Financial Planning and the International Association of Financial Planning. He is currently chairman of the Rockwall Goals Review Committee. In addition, he is a member of the Rockwall Planning and Zoning Commission, the Rockwall Airport Board and the Rockwall Economic Development Council.
